



Memorandum of Understanding between the European Society of Pathology and the European Neuroendocrine Tumor Society

The European Society of Pathology (ESP) and the European Neuroendocrine Tumor Society (ENETS) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 1st September 2016.

The purpose of the MoU is to memorise the mutual commitment of the parties to work together to enhance collaboration between the two organisations. Initially, this collaboration is focusing on clinical practice issues, educational matters and research activities in neuroendocrine tumour pathology. The achievement of both organisations' missions relies on a high level of collaboration with partner organisations throughout the world with shared objectives. The similarity of ESP and ENETS organisational objectives offers the opportunity to develop partnerships that will assist each organisation in meeting its goals.

The European Neuroendocrine Tumor Society (<https://www.enets.org>) is the leading interdisciplinary European professional organization which strives to improve the diagnosis and treatment of neuroendocrine tumours.
