

In the Symposium of the Amsterdam meeting, "TRIPLE NEGATIVE BC from morphology to molecular pathology", the speakers spanned from the histotypes of TNBC and their precursors to gene expression profiles and mutational analyses of this subset of tumors. The topics were new and intriguing. The speakers had great experience and showed the excellence of their research.

The **Slide Seminar** showed how variables are the lesions classified as B3 on pre-operative core biopsies. To this followed the **short course** on staging, which brought out the issues related to the new edition of AJCC staging.

The **joint meeting** outlined that still there are problems and difficulties in the diagnosis and management of breast cancer.

During the **Oral Free Paper Session** many interesting topics were presented. It was evident that breast pathologists are evolving towards new technologies, tests and showed also high interest for basic research.

The **Poster Session** was very rich and highly visited. The presenters were active and qualified and some of them were selected for "best posters".
