
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European School of Pathology (EScoP) course for Soft Tissue Pathology

This course will be an introduction to the subspecialty of Soft Tissue Pathology. The programme includes both theory lectures and real-life examples provided via case presentations. Participants will learn about the major classifications and types of Soft Tissue neoplasms. For each session there will be sufficient time for discussion, resulting to an interactive course.
